Mission Statement – 2003

Whereas the Canterbury Building Needs Committee was authorized and appointed at the 2001 Town Meeting to review the needs of the community at present and in the foreseeable future and assess the ability of Town properties to address those needs; and

Whereas the CBNC presented a comprehensive building plan of action at the 2003 Town Meeting which was approved by a two thirds majority of the voters present;

Now, therefore, it shall be the mission of the CBNC to implement the approved plan by meeting with architects, contractors and affected town departments, reviewing and recommending contracts to the Town Selectmen, monitoring and overseeing construction and renovations, and doing all that may be required to complete the project in a timely and cost efficient manner.

In the furtherance of this mission, it shall be the practice of the CBNC to make frequent reports to the Town, to inform the public through maintenance of a web site displaying minutes of meetings and show work in progress, and the holding of informational meetings as deemed appropriate.
